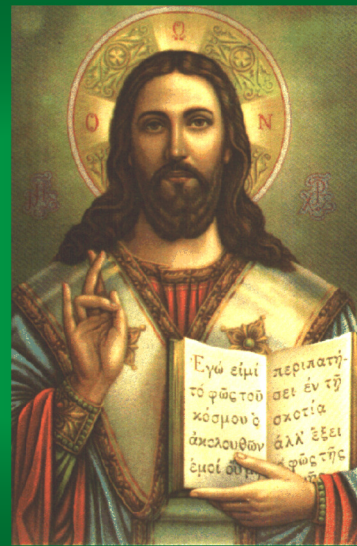

### PARISH CHRISTMAS FUNDRAISER
