### FATHER RICHARD CARTER

**T**his weekend Father Richard Carter, who last week retired from his post as Parish Priest at St. Joseph's, Pudsey begins his ministry in the parish. Whilst he has retired from being a Parish Priest, he will still be in active ministry! Some parishioners may recognise him from his visits to - the then - St. Patrick's Parish in the late 1980s when Fr. Mark Knowles was a priest here. Please give him a warm welcome and keep him in your prayers as he begins what is a very demanding ministry.

### FATHER SIMON'S INDUCTION

**F**ather Simon warmly invites all parishioners from across the parish to join him in celebrating the occasion of his **Induction as Parish Priest**.

The Induction will be by **Rev. Mgr. Paul Fisher**, the Diocesan Vicar General, and is the formal appointment of **Fr. Simon** as the new Parish Priest for the Parish of the Holy Redeemer.

It will all take place during a special Mass, which will begin at **11am** at St. Patrick's Church **this Wednesday (18 September)** and Father Simon would be delighted to see as many parishioners as possible for the Mass.
